Dear Homeowner,

It's been a busy spring and summer construction season and the major capital projects are all proceeding according to plan. This season's projects include:

- Deck replacement project on the back side of Building 15 including stair tower refurbishment and deck surface replacement:
 - Major construction is complete and stucco, trim work, partitions, landscaping, etc. will continue through August
- Natural gas fireplace conversion
 - The next installation phase will begin in late August after the summer season
- Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations
 - Great news! The chargers are in place and ready to use
 - The new charging stations are located in the Club parking lot and the overflow parking lot near the park
 - If you have an EV vehicle, please use the new chargers (plugging into common area 110 outlets will no longer be permitted)

This summer we've experienced a late and heavy pollen season, so the annual deck cleaning was postponed a few weeks. In anticipation of better conditions, the condominium decks are scheduled to be washed from July 13th through the 15th. To avoid water intrusion, please keep your doors and windows closed when the washing team is cleaning your building.

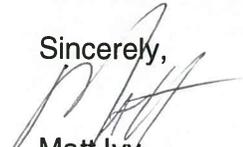
As a reminder, as of July 1st, the new Bike Barn Storage plan is in effect. If your bike(s) was previously registered and you would like to continue to use bike storage, please immediately respond to Iris Nelson at iris@vrcmr.com or by phone at 970-477-3060 and she will assist with your new bike registration and posting the fees to your homeowner account. Please be aware, the Association is in the process of removing unregistered bikes and, if they are not claimed they will be considered abandoned and will be donated.

For owners who do not wish to use the Bike Barn, extra bike racks are located between the tennis/pickleball courts and the playground. As Bike Barn spaces become available those owners who are currently on the waitlist will be contacted to register their bikes and gain access to the storage.

The Annual Homeowners Meeting is coming up next month and will be held Friday, August 13th at 2:00 PM. The meeting will be held remotely via Zoom, similar to last summer, and more information will follow in the coming weeks.

As with much of the country, the Vail area is suffering from a severe employee shortage. The VRCMR is among those businesses that have been unable to rehire former employees or attract new ones to fill important front-line positions.
